1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a. Basis of accounting and preparation of financial statements

The financial statements of the company have been prepared under the historical cost convention on the accrual basis of accounting and are in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles as adopted consistently unless explicitly stated otherwise. b. Use of Estimates

Contingent liabilities are not recognized but are disclosed in the notes. Contingent assets are neither recognized nor disclosed in the financial statements.

j. Impairment of Assets

The objective of AS-28 is to ensure that the assets of an organization are carried at no more than its recoverable amounts. If the carrying amounts exceed the recoverable amount, then "loss on impairment of assets" needs to be recognized in the books. There are no losses from impairment of assets to be recognized in the financial statements.
